

ABOUT GFOUNDATION

Gfoundation is a Christian international development organization founded in South Korea in 2016. Rooted in the mission to love others as God loves us, we partner with churches and community-based groups to address urgent local and global challenges—especially those affecting vulnerable and underserved populations. In 2021, our growing impact was recognized with Special Consultative Status by the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).

To broaden our reach and strengthen our presence in the United States, Gfoundation established its U.S. office as an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit based in New York.

Though legally distinct, the U.S. entity shares the same mission and values as its Korean counterpart. United in purpose, we work across borders to extend dignity, compassion, and care to underserved communities.

STAND WITH SINGLE MOTHERS

Supporting Single Mothers in the U.S.

Our Single Mothers Support initiative provides monthly essentials and celebrates meaningful moments with single mothers—through gift drives, shared meals, worship gatherings, and personal encouragement.

In neighborhoods like Paterson (NJ) and Fort Lee (NJ), we've built trusted relationships by showing up consistently—reminding mothers that they are seen, supported, and never alone.

In addition to core supplies, we provided seasonal gifts and joined local events—creating safe, uplifting spaces where single mothers felt connected and cared for.

Through ongoing emotional, financial, and social support, we aim to reduce isolation and offer dignity and care to those who need it most.

DIGNITY FOR EVERY GIRL

Fighting Period Poverty in Africa

In underserved communities across Africa, girls are often forced to reuse cloth rags instead of sanitary pads—putting them at greater risk of infection. Many students miss school and stay home during their periods, falling behind in their education.

To change this, we have led cross-border missions throughout Africa—distributing sanitary pads and promoting menstrual health education in partnership with local schools and youth centers in Chad, The Gambia, and Morocco.



Through our Period Poverty Worldwide initiative, we:

- · Delivered safe, hygienic menstrual products to girls in need
- Increased school attendance during menstruation
- · Identified critical gaps in school health programs to shape future solutions
- Reached girls in crisis-affected areas with urgent care and support

REBUILDING COMMUNITIES

LIGHTING THE WAY FOR REFUGEES

Supporting Refugee Families in the U.S.

For refugee families rebuilding their lives in unfamiliar cities, the first years can be especially isolating. By providing practical assistance and emotional connections, we've helped refugee families feel seen, empowered, and connected as they work toward stability and belonging.



Since October 2024, Gfoundation has partnered with local churches and organizations to support refugee families in Syracuse (NY), Louisville (KY), and Dayton (OH)—providing personal care items and seasonal gifts such like menstrual products, cosmetics, clothing, and toys.

During major holidays like Thanksgiving and Christmas, we have visited families in person to deliver gifts, offer prayers, and remind them that they are not alone.

PROTECT DIGNITY

Supporting Seniors Living Alone in the U.S.


Harsh winters can be especially difficult for seniors living alone, often with limited support. In response, we launched our Senior Support initiative—providing essentials like warm clothing, blankets, and seasonal items.

In December 2024, we partnered with Neighbor Plus to deliver winter essentials to 18 seniors in Flushing (NY) and Palisades Park (NJ). Each kit was delivered to bring comfort, care, and dignity to isolated seniors in underserved communities.

Supporting Low-Income Families

We've also reached out to low-income families with everyday essentials—and more importantly, with presence. By spending time together and listening to their stories, we've reminded families that even in difficult times, they are not alone and never forgotten.





FRAME OUR MOMENT

Gifting Family Portraits in Madagascar

In low-income areas of Madagascar, many families rarely have the chance to capture memories together. That's why we launched Frame Our Moment offering professional family portraits as lasting gifts.

Through the lens of African photography specialist and Gfoundation ambassador Shin Misik, we've gifted portraits to 170 families—creating moments of dignity, recognition, and connection.





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WASH & HEALTH

SAFE TOILETS, SAVE CHILDREN

Improving Hygiene Conditions in Ethiopia

Many public schools in Ethiopia lack access to clean water and basic sanitation. Without proper toilets or hygiene education, students face preventable illnesses and disruptions to their learning.

To address this urgent need, we supported the establishment of our Ethiopia branch in 2024 and the rollout of a large-scale WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) project—organized by Gfoundation Korea in partnership with the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA).



The initiative has improved hygiene conditions in schools by:

- Renovating and building sanitation facilities
- Training teachers in hygiene practices
- · Promoting a lasting hygiene culture through school and family engagement



Goals of the Initiative

- Reduce preventable illnesses by improving hygiene infrastructure
- Promote health education through student and teacher leadership
- Foster sustainable hygiene practices within school communities





HOPE BEGINS WITH SAFE BIRTHS

Enhancing Maternal Healthcare in Madagascar

In remote areas of Madagascar, many mothers face childbirth without access to proper medical care—leading to preventable complications and loss. To address this, we launched Hope Madagascar, an initiative focused on improving maternal health in medically underserved areas by training local OB-GYNs, equipping clinics with portable ultrasound devices, and reducing maternal and infant



mortality. The initiative also invests in long-term capacity by fostering education and mentorship for local healthcare providers. Full implementation—including on-the-ground impact—has continued into 2025.
