## 1 WOMEN & GIRLS EMPOWERMENT

### Supporting Shelters Toward Stability

#### Women's Shelter Care Kit Program

We began a new partnership with a single mothers' shelter in the Bronx, New York, serving approximately 27 mothers who are either pregnant or caring for infants under one year old.

During our visit, GFoundation listened and learned more about the urgent needs these mothers face. In response, we provided essential hygiene supplies to support their daily lives.

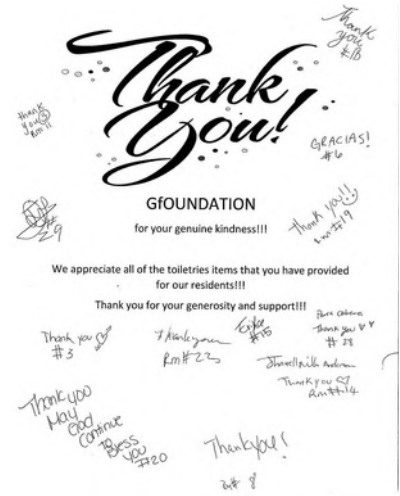
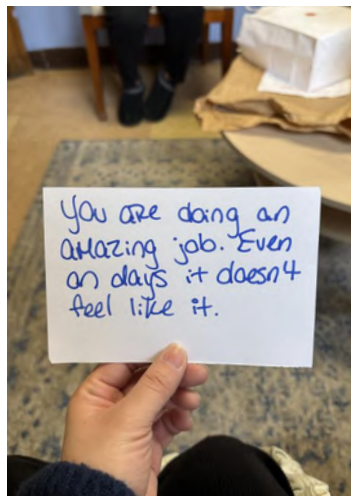
This visit also became a meaningful starting point, leading to the launch of our Hygiene Kit Support Program for women's shelters across New York and New Jersey.

## Honoring All Mothers

### Holiday Gift Giving & Care Program

For many single mothers and refugee mothers, Mother’s Day can feel just like another difficult day—without flowers, family brunches, or words of appreciation.

This year, thanks to the kindness of our supporters and partners, more than 60 mothers across New Jersey and Syracuse, NY, felt remembered, cherished, and honored.

We also reached out to vulnerable mothers in our communities during holidays such as Thanksgiving and Christmas, sharing handwritten cards, decorations, and personalized gifts. In total, 172 gifts were distributed to mothers through these efforts.

**Beyond personal gifts, we provided essential household supplies such as power towels, bath tissue, and laundry detergent—items families identified as urgent needs.**

## Delivering Monthly Essentials Through Home Visits

### Single-Mother Family Monthly Support Program

Volunteers conducted home visits to families enrolled in our monthly essential goods support program.

Because many of these households face transportation challenges, we partnered with Neighbor Plus, a local nonprofit in Palisades Park, NJ, to deliver food and daily necessities directly to their homes while gaining a better understanding of their living conditions.

These visits brought not only practical relief, but also moments of connection, encouragement, and prayer. Mothers shared how meaningful it was to open their doors and receive these packages face-to-face—reminders that they are seen, valued, and never alone.

## COMMUNITY HEALTH & WASH

### Hope Madagascar: Expanding Maternal Healthcare

#### Maternal Diagnostic Access Program

In Madagascar, where access to diagnostic equipment remains limited, GFoundation expanded maternal healthcare through the Hope Madagascar campaign by providing 20 portable ultrasound machines and supporting 334 ultrasound examinations. By enabling OB-GYNs to detect complications early, the initiative contributed to timely, life-saving care for mothers and infants while helping improve health outcomes in underserved communities.

## School-Based WASH Initiative in Ethiopia

### Safe Water & Sanitation Program

Through a school-based WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) initiative in Sebeta and Gelanguda, Sheger City, we improved sanitation and hygiene education across 10 public schools in partnership with GFoundation Ethiopia Regional Office. Toilet upgrades, handwashing facilities, and teacher training created safer learning environments for more than 8,000 students. Over 30 student-led WASH club campaigns further promoted hygiene awareness and healthier practices.
